III.01 Senate Inauguration, Action Item

Elected 2023-2024 ASCC Senators were inaugurated by Vice President Dweik.

III.02 Inauguration of Chief Justice, Action Item

The ASCC Senate took action to approve Serafina Chun as the ASCC Chief Justice.

Senator Dunomes moves to approve Serafina Chun as the ASCC Chief Justice, Senator Mejia seconds. No objections, motion passes. Chief Justice Chun is absent due to class and will be sworn in at her first Court meeting.

III.03 Inauguration of Executive Cabinet, Action Item

The ASCC Senate took action to approve the 2023-2024 Executive Cabinet members outlined in Executive Order 2324-01.

- Voted by Senate, vote to occur next meeting: President Pro Tempore, Sergeant at Arms, Faculty Senate Liaison
- Voted by caucus of party members: Minority Leader, Majority Leader
 - o Freshman status means a student who has completed less than 30 units.
 - Sophomore status means a student who has completed 30 or more units.
 - Whichever class standing has the most members will be the Majority Party, with the other group being the Minority Party.
- Appointed by President, approved by Senate (outlined in Article V, Section 2, Subsection 13): Party Whip
