10 and legal standards and establish the direction for planning and college  
11 operations;
- 12 • Assure the Board operates in an open, accessible, welcoming spirit, and  
13 maintains an anti-racist culture;
- 14 • Establish policies that ensure the District operates in an anti-racist manner;
- 15 • Hire and evaluate the President/Superintendent;
- 16 • Delegate power and authority to the President/Superintendent to effectively lead  
17 the District;
- 18 • Assure fiscal health and stability, by adopting a responsible annual budget,  
19 assuring fiscal oversight, and providing for independent audits;
- 20 • Monitor institutional performance and educational quality; and
- 21 • Advocate for and protect the District.
