1 **BP 3520 LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT**

5 The District shall enter into a written agreement with the local law enforcement agency.
6 The agreement shall clarify operational responsibilities for investigations of Part I violent
7 crimes, defined by law as willful homicide, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault,
8 occurring at each location operated by the District.

9 The written agreement shall designate which law enforcement agency shall have
10 operational responsibility for violent crimes and delineate the specific geographical
11 boundaries of each agency's operational responsibility, including maps as necessary.

12 The written agreements required by this policy shall be public records and shall be made
13 available for inspection by members of the public upon request.

14 The Cerritos Community College District encourages accurate and prompt reporting of all
15 crimes to the Campus Police Department and/or the appropriate police agencies. The
16 President/Superintendent shall establish procedures that encourage pastoral counselors
17 and professional counselors, if and when they deem it appropriate, to inform the persons
18 they are counseling of any procedures to report crimes on a voluntary, confidential basis
19 for inclusion in the annual disclosure of crime statistics.
