- 12 do have three speaker cards. I
- 13 would like to call Mr. --
- 14 [INAUDIBLE] Nigerian and he will
- 15 be talk on the matter of hiring
- 16 full time faculty positions
- 17 >> And I got a gift. Sorry. I
- 18 won't -- good evening everyone.

- 19 Very intimate group tonight.
- 20 Hello President Fierro and Board
- 21 of Trustees and my colleagues
- 22 and friends. I am here
- 23 representing the Fine Arts
- 24 Department regarding the recent
- 25 decision to reduce the number of

- 1 full time positions for the
- 2 year. This news came us to last
- 3 Friday via Email through Vice
- 4 President Fierro. It causes a
- 5 little bit of problem in our
- 6 area and I want to specify why.
- 7 I mean we did this very
- 8 diplomatically through the
- 9 Faculty Hiring Prioritization
- 10 Committee and I was on that
- 11 committee. I do feel that
- 12 committee was kind of a data
- 13 driven process that left out a
- 14 lot of specifics to the areas
- 15 like mine that got left out.
- 16 Why is it important we replace
- 17 our position? It's ceramics and

- 18 3D. We have a new building.
- 19 It's been very successful and
- 20 actually our enrollment is very
- 21 good and Steven Portico retired.
- 22 It's the whole almost 2/3 of the
- 23 first floor. It's a health and
- 24 safety issue really. We
- 25 currently have adjunct faculty

- 1 piecing it together and adult
- 2 hourly who are over worked.
- 3 There are glass kilns there,
- 4 chemicals and glazes that are
- 5 done there that need full
- 6 professional supervision by a
- 7 full timer. You don't have to
- 8 dig too far. There were 34
- 9 retirees last year. If they
- 10 hired all 24 they said they were
- 11 going to in the first round you
- 12 would still be saving money. We
- 13 have a \$70 million surplus.
- 14 We're projecting six million
- 15 dollars this year. To borrow

- 16 Solomen's quote "Are we a banker17 or education institution here?"18 It's not helping students or
- 19 faculty. President Fierro
- 20 supports the art and has been to
- 21 our functions and we provide a
- 22 lot of good things to the campus
- 23 community. And again anyone
- 24 that needs a replacement
- 25 position ours is pretty

- 1 detrimental because I think it's
- 2 a health and safety issue and
- 3 also just the momentum and
- 4 rapport of the program. If you
- 5 don't know what the Art
- 6 Department does and I think in
- 7 this case the categories that
- 8 did the FHP and didn't allow me
- 9 to specialize on what we do that
- 10 and why we need the importance
- 11 of this job. So I don't know if
- 12 I can change minds and we like
- 13 to did our jobs and you're doing
- 14 your job and moving forward and

- 15 I would encourage maybe the
- 16 President to sway the Trustees
- 17 and can go over that FON number.
- 18 Again we didn't see the FON
- 19 number to advertise the position
- 20 and we had over 60 applicants
- 21 apply and say sorry we're not
- 22 doing this. We don't look good.
- 23 Anyway that's an embarrassment.
- 24 Thank you for your time. The
- 25 Fine Art Department is making

- 1 the request and say please do
- 2 this. Another year without a
- 3 full time faculty member in that
- 4 position causes a lot of
- 5 problems and I have been here
- 6 since 1999 and at these meetings
- 7 and it's sad that we're
- 8 squabbling over this and it's a
- 9 business and the time and the
- 10 money and not the human
- 11 condition of the students or the
- 12 faculty and what we're trying to

- 13 do when we work. Thank you for
  14 your time.
  15 >> President Avalos: Great.
  16 Thank you very much for your
  - 18 Mr. Scott Collins.
  - 19 >> Good evening President

comments. Next we have

I want 15 to apologize to the board if I offended anyone in the times I 17 have spoken before the board. As 19 you may guess I am passionate about serving the needs of the 20 students of Cerritos College and their continued success. I love working for Cerritos College and like many faculty have expressed 25 I am thankful for my job. I Sample footer

- 1 want to the board to know that I
- 2 value my job and made the
- 3 changes necessary to improve to
- 4 the best of my ability. It is
- 5 been no secret that I have been
- 6 struggling personally with an
- 7 increasingly hostile environment
- 8 in the Math Department. This has

- 9 resulted in complaints to Human
- 11 and Human Resources sitting in

Resources. Aside from Personnel

- 12 our Math Department meetings
- 13 nothing came of my complaints.
- 14 In regards to my teaching all of
- 15 my trianuial evaluations up
- 16 until the Administrative Review
- 17 has been satisfactory. During
- 18 my last evaluation the former
- 19 SCM Dean went so far to ask my
- 20 evaluators to mark me
- 21 unsatisfactory but they
- 22 wouldn't. The Administrative
- 23 Review Committee included the
- 24 individual that is most hostile
- 25 to me, the academic bully of the

- department and this person was
- 2 allowed to serve all my
- 3 Administrative Review Team. I
- 4 asked for a new Administrative
- 5 EvaluationCommittee free from
- 6 the bias of other committees and

- 7 have been denied. My student
  8 rating of instructor evaluations
  9 which weren't in the
  10 administrative review included
  - 11 "Ms. Mata is excellent math
  - 12 teacher and really help me to
  - 13 enjoy and understand math and an
  - 14 excellent and caring teacher
  - 15 that provides students with the
  - 16 tools of success." This clearly
  - 17 indicates I have been meeting
  - 18 the needs of students. My
  - 19 administrative review process
  - 20 has been punitive in nature
- 21 instead of emphasizing continual
- 22 improvement of instruction as
- 23 set forth in Article 16.1 of the
- 24 CCFF contract. The
- 25 Administrative Review Committee

- 1 has failed to provide me clear
- 2 actionable recommendations.
- 3 Instead offering me vague
- 4 recommendations that raises more
- 5 questions than answers. The

- 6 committee has failed to provide
- 7 reasonable assistance for
- 8 improvement under article 16.8.3
- 9 instead out right refusing to
- 10 assist me by providing direction
- 11 and written clarification of the
- 12 recommendations. I have made
- 13 changes in good faith but
- 14 without clear guidelines on what
- 15 to work toward I will always
- 16 fall short. This is not about
- 17 instructional improvement but
- 18 instead getting someone trying
- 19 to get rid of someone trying to
- 20 improve the Math Department.
- 21 Thank you.
- 22 >> President Avalos: Great
- 23 thank you Ms. Mata. I
- 24 appreciate your comments
- 25 tonight. We have no other

- 1 speaker cards but I know some
- 2 folks are in traffic. Anyone
- 3 who didn't get here in time and

- 4 just arrived and like to speak?
- 5 All right. Seeing no one else I
- 6 will close the comment portion
- 7 of public comment tonight. Next
- 8 moving on to the next item. We
- 9 have reports and comments from
- 10 constituent groups. We have
- 11 ASCC. Faculty, CCFF, CSEA and
- 12 ACCME so I will start off with
- 13 the Associated Student College
- 14 President. Is anyone here on
- 15 their behalf? No. Okay. How
- 16 about Faculty Senate President.
- 17 Okay. Thank you.
- 18 >> Good evening Board of
- 19 Trustees, and Dr. Fierro and
- 20 audience members. My name is
- 21 Lisa Boutella and I am Secretary
- 22 of Faculty Senate. I am
- 23 representing the Senate tonight
- 24 because April Griffin couldn't
- 25 attend. I would like to share

- 1 some concerns that were voiced
- 2 during Faculty Senate yesterday

- 3 due to the recent news that
- 4 Cerritos College would no longer
- 5 be hiring 27 new full time
- 6 faculty that were announced in
- 7 the fall semester. Instead we
- 8 would be hiring only 13 to
- 9 account for the downward
- 10 revision in the FON number. The
- 11 Faculty Senate appreciates that
- 12 the Administration has already
- 13 identified areas of improvement
- 14 by better aligning planning and
- 15 hiring timelines with the
- 16 Chancellor's Office so that this
- 17 type of adjustment doesn't need
- 18 to be made in the future. The
- 19 Faculty Senate however continues
- 20 to have some concerns that I
- 21 will share briefly. First we
- 22 believe that fully staffing our
- 23 faculty will help to support
- 24 student success and completions
- and thus benefit the college in

- 1 light of the new funding
- 2 formula. With the full time
- 3 faculty retirements that
- 4 occurred last year many programs
- 5 are struggling with low morale,
- 6 extra work load and loss of
- 7 program and institutional
- 8 knowledge. Second Faculty
- 9 Senators were concerned that
- 10 these positions were listed on
- 11 the HR website and then removed.
- 12 We hope that all applicants will
- 13 be contacted so they know their
- 14 applications are appreciated and
- 15 so the removal of the positions
- 16 doesn't reflect poorly on the
- 17 college and discourage future
- 18 applicants. Third there is
- 19 concern about adult education
- 20 not being part of the FON. We
- 21 heard from Vice President
- 22 Miranda that there was a
- 23 Chancellor's meeting about this
- 24 and we hope there is a prompt
- 25 solution to this problem.

- 1 Lastly we realize that the Board
- 2 of Trustees included a
- 3 Resolution as part of the SERP
- 4 to not hire above the FON but
- 5 many programs are truly in need
- 6 of full time faculty members so
- 7 we hope that you might over ride
- 8 the rule in some cases. My own
- 9 department as was discussed was
- 10 originally granted a hire for
- 11 ceramics and 3D design but now
- 12 this position has been removed.
- 13 While this might not seem like
- 14 an extremely urgent position as
- 15 he described we do have some
- 16 health and safety issues that
- 17 we're concerned about and with a
- 18 large percentage of the Fine
- 19 Arts building dedicated to
- 20 ceramics we have no full time
- 21 faculty member overseeing it.
- 22 In light of the comments we hope
- 23 that you support the full time
- 24 staffing levels. The challenge
- 25 of adult education and the

- 1 extenuating circumstances that
- 2 some programs are facing. Thank
- 3 you so much.
- 4 >> President Avalos: Thank
- 5 you very much for your updates.
- 6 Next we have Cerritos College
- 7 Faculty Federation is there any
- 8 comment? No? Thank you very
- 9 much and we have our Classified
- 10 School Employee Association
- 11 President. Would you Ms. Houge
- 12 -- correct? She's our new
- 13 President and I don't know if
- 14 you have any comments tonight?
- 15 >> [Off Mic].
- 16 >> President Avalos: Great.
- 17 Thank you. Last but not least
- 18 we have the Association of
- 19 Cerritos College Management
- 20 Employees. Any representative
- 21 here tonight? Okay. Seeing
- 22 none we'll move on to our Item
- 23 Number 4which is Institutional
- 24 Presentation. We do have

- 1 and Dr. Nick Van Dean of
- 2 Technology will give that
- 3 presentation.
- 4 >> Thank you for taking the
- 5 time to recognize our retiree.
- 6 Tonight I am presenting Carolyn
- 7 Reed who is sitting over here
- 8 with the nice blue dress. She
- 9 began employment in December '97
- 10 on the campus working on as a
- 11 dispensary lab tech assistant in
- 12 the Cosmetology Department. She
- 13 received her Cosmetology license
- 14 from L.A. Trade Tech and
- 15 received more than 10 trophies
- 16 in student competitions when
- 17 working there. She spent 15
- 18 years working at various salons
- 19 until she joined the Cerritos
- 20 family. What she loved the most
- 21 work in the dispensary lab
- 22 helping the students to mix
- 23 formulas correctly. She loved

- 24 being a hair dresser and passed
- 25 on her passion to the students.
