1. CALL TO ORDER

Don Mueller called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m. via ConferZoom.

2. APPROVAL OF THE OCTOBER 18, 2023 MEETING SUMMARY

The October 18, 2023 minutes were postponed until the next meeting.

3. PRESENTATION BY ROBYN BRAMMER, AMBER HROCH & FRANK MIXSON

Robyn Brammer, Amber Hroch and Frank Mixson made a presentation to the District Safety Committee. They are making this presentation to each committee at Cerritos College.

4. CURRENT CONSTRUCTION – STATUS UPDATE

Anthony Parker said, he was going to send out a notification later today regarding the perimeter changing around the SSA building site, on December 20, 2023. This will encompass the entire parking lots of 2 & 3; most of the parking lot in front of the Gym will be taken up. Irrigation related repairs are also going on throughout the campus, as there are many holes. I am trying to have our Facilities Team be more responsible in that regard. Our contractors, working on the Health Science renovation, ran out of parking space in within their fence perimeter; therefore, more construction workers will be walking from Lot 10 to their work site. We are still trying to relabel our parking lots, so you will see stripping going on and ongoing as the year progresses. There is a lot of arrows that are faded, as well as markings that say “STOP”; we are going to focus on taking care of these.

Don Mueller asked if there were any more questions on construction. Victoria Vaja asked about STOP sign near the PAC building near “old” Falcon Way. Anthony Parker said consultants have been on campus trying to re-define how traffic is supposed to navigate those spaces of the college. Irving Bartikofsky said that in the parking lot, in front of the SS building, there is a lot of students being dropped off or picked up instead of them making a

left to the front of the Administration building where it is designated as a drop-off & pickup. Anthony Parker said the “new” drop-off will be more circular than what is already there. There will also be a traffic light out in front, on Alondra Boulevard. Don Mueller said that he and Anthony Parker will walk it to see about some type of solution.

5. NARCAN & AED UPDATES

Don Mueller said this item will be tabled until the next meeting due to Hillary Mennella’s absence.

6. POLICE PERSONNEL UPDATE / NEW OFFICE HIRING

Don Mueller said that there are still going to hire two (2) officer vacancies: one (1) full-time vacancy and one (1) new full-time position; both have been approved, by Executive Council.

Don Mueller said this is postponed until the next meeting.
