## 1 COUNTER-PROPOSAL 2 FROM THE CERRITOS COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT TO THE 3 **CERRITOS COLLEGE FACULTY FEDERATION, AFT Local 6215** 4 5 May 10, 2024 6 7 This proposal from the Cerritos Community College District to the Cerritos College Faculty 8 Federation, AFT Local 6215 ("CCFF") is expressly made pursuant to the Education Employment 9 Relations Act and the current Collective Bargaining Agreement between the parties. The following 10 article shall be deemed to remain unchanged in the Collective Bargaining Agreement except as 11 set forth below: 12 13 **ARTICLE 34:** 14 **ACADEMIC RANK** 15 Academic rank is an honorific that is separate and distinct from the hiring or 16 accreditation requirements for any given position, and may be granted separate 17 from any verified minimum qualifications. The grant of Academic Rank titles shall 18 not be have any impact to unit member placement on the Cerritos College Salary 19 Schedule, nor be a factor in determining salary. As of July 1, 2024, the definitions 20 21 and qualifications listed in 34.1 shall be used to determine Academic Rank for faculty at Cerritos College. In the event that a currently employed faculty member 22 would be demoted in Academic Rank due to the change in definition, the faculty 23 shall retain their original Academic Rank. 24 25 34.1 Academic Rank: Definitions and Qualifications 26 27 28 34.1.1 As of July 1, 2024, the definitions and qualifications listed 29 in 34.1.2-6 shall be used to determine Academic Rank for 30 faculty at Cerritos College.
