#### Providing ASCC Positions for the 2022 General Election JR-2223-03

**Whereas:** The 2022 federal, state, and local general election is scheduled to occur on November 8, 2022; and

**Whereas:** Per the terms of JR-2223-01, ASCC has the ability to support ballot measures and other parts of elections as long as it does so in a non-partisan manner; and

**Whereas:** Other universities, such as California State University, Long Beach, publish recommendations of passage of state legislation and other appropriate measures; and

**Whereas:** The ASCC Cabinet has formed the following list of ballot measures and stances:

- County Measure A (Providing Authority to Remove Sheriff): SUPPORT
- Measure CC (Cerritos College \$425M Bond): SUPPORT
- State Measure 1 (Reproductive Freedom): SUPPORT
- State Measure 26 and 27 (Regarding Gambling): OPPOSE 26, OPPOSE 27
- State Measure 28 (Funding Arts/Music in K-12): SUPPORT
- State Measure 30 (Wealth Tax, Air Pollution/Wildfire Prevention): SUPPORT

**Let it be resolved:** The Associated Students of Cerritos College hereby endorses or opposes all of the aforementioned ballot measures; and let it be further

**Resolved:** This resolution shall, per JR-2223-01, be disseminated to the student body through ASCC social media; and let it be further

**Resolved:** ASCC shall, as applicable in its normal election publicity, promote voting in the general election for all who are eligible; and let it be further
