Funding for Sociology Club Events Fall 2021 SB-2122-01

Whereas: “Transfer Information Session” on October 19, 2021 from 11am-12:30pm on Zoom. This event includes hearing from a panel of recently transferred sociology majored students from Cerritos College. They will share their transfer experiences and learn about the transfer requirements and process from our transfer counselor Brittany Lundeen.

Whereas: “Careers in Sociology” on November 16, 2021 from 11am-12:30pm on Zoom. This event will discuss various sociology majors fields. Students will hear from folks with a background in Sociology who are now in law, non-profit organizations, urban-planning, research and development, and social work. This event will help students gather additional information and ideas that will help pursue a higher education and career choice within Sociology.

Whereas: The funding is requested as follows:

- Transfer Information Session: \$200 total for 4 Alumni Speakers, awarding each \$50 in honorarium.
- Careers in Sociology Session: \$400 total for 4 Professional Guest Speakers, awarding each \$100 in honorarium.

Resolved: The ASCC Senate will fund the Sociology Club events for a total of \$600.00 from the ASCC Senate Fund 600-03-015 for honorarium.
