III.03 Funding for UndocuLEADERS NCORE Conference, Discussion Item, 10 minutes

The Senate shall act on SB-2324-08 funding in the amount of \$10,670 from the Senate fund, to fund for 6 student club board members to attend the 26th Annual National Conference on Race & Ethnicity in Higher Education conference.

Questions:

- So what's the current balance of Senate funds? \$17,40,000.00 from \$40,000.00
- What have the UndocuLeaders done for the campus, have they fundraised?
 - Past couple years trouble getting advisor
 - The club has done fundraising
- So what was the money from the fundraiser used on?
 - has used the money from agua frescas to purchase tote bags and notebook to have another fundraiser.
 - they haven't had another fundraiser from them yet.
 - How much revenue is expected from the fundraiser?
 - o still doing inventory, and can have numbers by next week

Senator Gonzalez moves to extend time by 7 minutes, seconded by Senator Bui. No objections the motion passes.

- When is the next fundraising to help toward these costs? When is the Conference?
 - o Conference from May 28 thru June
 - o Fundraising end of March
- Have you registered?
 - Not yet
- Would it be better to come back after the fundraiser and see how much you need? How Much are you estimating from fundraising? What are you planning to earn?
 - o less than \$500 rough estimate
- What happens if the cost of airfare rises, and you run out of budget?
 - Would need to do fundraising.

Discussion

- Senator Ochoa recommends the group to come back after fundraising to see how much would be needed.
- Advisor Miller- Senate can determine if they fund a lower amount as blanket, and the club would have to fundraise the rest.

Senator Poliquin-Hernandez moves to amend the legislation by striking the 'Flights' and 'Meals' rows from the item budget and Reducing the overall budget to \$6,470 and inserting that amount in the final Whereas and in the Resolved. seconded by Senator Ochoa. No objections, the motion passes .

Senator Poliquin Hernandez moves to approve the SB-2324-08 as amended, seconded by Senator Gonzalez. No objections, the motion passes
