    - Before the end of February, Admissions will be sending email reminders to students to remind them of the petition deadline. We will also begin posting Commencement information on the Commencement webpage: www.cerritos.edu/commencement, this month and early March.

#### ii. Grad Fair

- 1. Proposed dates of event: 5/5 and 5/12 from 10am-7pm both days.
- 2. Only pre-ordered regalia and items to be distributed at the event. There will be nothing available to purchase during this event.
- 3. Honors cords will be distributed at the event. We are working out the details on how to incorporate that into the event.

4. The campus is considering whether or not we will be able to have photography services from Grad Images on our premises during the event. Grad Images does have a COVID safe appointment only plan available, which will be reviewed by VPSS.

#### iii. Pre-Recorded Commencement Ceremony

- 1. Plan is to have the pre-recorded video premiere on the campus YotTube page on Thursday, May 27<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 PM.
- 2. Transfer Celebration will be holding their event on May 27th from 12-2pm.

### iv. Online Graduate Gallery

#### v. Carmencement

- 2. Vehicle route was reviewed by the committee.
- 3. We plan to use SARS for student RSVPs and to help us scheduled the appointments in effort to space out the attendees
- 4. We are working with Orbit Rentals to provide the event equipment rentals for the Alondra Drop Off Zone aka "Red Carpet Zone", where students will receive their diploma cover and have name announced.
