 - Next step: Dean Miller will bring the BP to Shared Governance.
 - Dean Miller plans to bring present the changes to Faculty Senate and ACCME.
 - \circ Goal is to publish the new revision for the next academic year, 2021-2022.

- The committee will discuss continuation of the sub-committee to review BP500 Standards of Student Conduct, and AP 5520 Student Discipline Procedures
 - o Committee established an AP 5520 sub-committee to review and make edits to the AP.
 - AP 5520 sub-committee will be: Elizabeth Miller, Cynthia Lavariere, Claudia Quilizapa, Debra Ward, and Maria Isai.
 - Revision approval for Administrative Procedures will be a quicker process and will go to Coordinating Committee.
 - o Goal is to publish the new AP 5520 revisions for the next academic year, 2021-2022.

4. Information & Discussion: Commencement 2020 & 2021

- The committee discussed commencement options for spring 2021, and the in-person option for class of 2020 should public health guidelines allow.
 - Committee suggestions provided:
 - Send out another survey to students to get their input for 2021. Students really appreciated that they were able to provide feedback for the 2020 ceremony options.
 - Marching Order:
 - Establish a ceremony time, where student can login together. The link will continue running for a few weeks after.
 - Organize and improve the ceremony videos and their quality.
 - Security: Lock in ceremony security, just in case it will be held in person.
 - Creative options:
 - Drive-thru graduate experience.
 - Committee hopes to have a decision made of what direction we the campus will take for the spring 2021 commencement exercises, by early spring 2021 (January).
