### 1. Welcome: Attendance & Quorum

- **Committee Quorum:** The committee reviewed its quorum requirement. The current quorum requirement is 35 percent in the fall semester and 50 percent + 1 in the spring semester, both based on the total membership.

### 2. Discussion: Committee Goals for 2018-2019

- The committee will discuss and continue finalizing goals for the academic year.
- Finalized goals (from May 2018):
  1. In collaboration with Disabled Student Programs and Services (DSPS), assist with development and distribution on guidelines/resources on making campus events and activities universally accessible.
    - a. Universal Access Task Force will develop a guideline for the Committee to market to campus.
  2. Explore needs related to establishment of a cross-cultural center at Cerritos College. (Goal carried over from 2017-2018).
  3. Explore strategies to increase communication for events and activities on campus.

### 3. Discussion- Grade Grievance Procedure Revisions

- The committee will received an update on the pending revisions to AP 5530.
  - Timeline revisions are proposed to establish consistency with the procedure.
  - Proposed timeline revisions will be submitted to the Coordinating Committee for approval and finalization this year.

### 4. Information & Discussion: Commencement 2019

- The date for the 61<sup>st</sup> Annual Commencement Ceremony is May 24, 2019.
- Commencement Speaker
  - The committee discussed the commencement speaker nomination process and the idea to have speaker nominations include a distinguished student, faculty member, or alumni.
  - Committee discussed the pros and cons of selecting student as Speaker:
    - Pros: relatable, engaging, increase attendance, reflects their experience, selection process, inspirational.
    - Cons: too many options, giving a student a platform to share their own opinions, inexperienced, reliability, timing and competitiveness.
  - Committee discussed the pros and cons of selecting alumni as Speaker:
    - Pros: Local selections, Cerritos College background, "Hall of Fame"- Large pool of alumni from various backgrounds.
    - Cons: Personal platform can be risky.
  - Committee members briefly discussed ideas for nominee selection criteria: audition, essay, interview, speech submission, etc. A draft of selection criteria requirements will be made available at the next committee meeting.
- Executive Council will need to provide input on the speaker selection nominations/ recommendations.
- Former student representatives on the Committee have requested that Commencement speakers are relatable and have a connection to Cerritos College, and are non-politicized.

- SWOT Analysis results of the 2018 Commencement Ceremony will be provided and discussed at the next committee meeting.

#### **5. Cerritos College Food Court & Vending Services**

- RFP Vendor walk-through took place August 31 and September 1. Applicants were able to view the vending locations available on campus.
