A BILL

Esports Funding Request SB-2122-09

Whereas: Esports has been growing as an industry for years.

Whereas: Cerritos College is starting an Esports program to include the Falcon gaming community to participate in Falcon Life on campus. This new program does not have any funding.

Whereas: Cerritos College Esports will consist of hosting games in a virtual setting for students to get students involved in co-curricular opportunities on campus by participating in games such as League of Legends, Super Smash Brothers, Mario Kart and Pokemon Brilliant Diamond and Shining Pearl (BDSP).

Whereas: Games are scheduled through the end of the semester on Thursdays at 2:00 P.M.

Whereas: Funding request includes: Esports jerseys, t-shirts and hats to give to participating students and winners of the games. Based on how many points they have at the end of the semester; they will get one or all of the items. Gaming chairs for the Student Activities employees hosting the games. Purchase of the Pokemon BDSP game to host the game. The game will be kept in the department as the property of Student Activities. Need for necessary cables, and laptop coolers to avoid overheating of laptops during the games. Lastly, an online annual Nintendo subscription to host the games from our Nintendo Switch.
