I. Organizational Items

I.01 Call to Order

President Frausto called the meeting to order at 2:06 PM

I.02 Roll Call

There were 17 present, 4 absent, 0 late, and 0 excused in today's meeting.

I.03 Approval of Minutes

Director thompson approved the minutes seconded by Director Ramirez

I.04 Approval of Agenda

Director Gaffield approved the minutes and was seconded by Director Diaz

II. Public Forum

This time is reserved for members of the public who wish to address the Associated Students of Cerritos College Cabinet members on issues of concerns, public comment, future events, fundraisers, and any topic relating to Cerritos College and their constituents. A limit of three (3) minutes per speaker and nine (9) minutes per topic will be enforced. This is not a time for discussion by the ASCC Cabinet; however, the President or Cabinet members may respond to specific questions and concerns made by the public.

Track and field coach Michael Allen & Chris Richardson presented an Southern California Regional event that will be happening over 2 weeks in May. There will be lots of student activity with 80-90 teams representing both genders. It will be happening from May 3rd to May 10th in the stadium in the morning through to the afternoon. Coach Richardson is asking for volunteers to help out with the event along with engaging with students on campus. 1,000 athletes and coaches will be visiting for this event.

Senator Garcia made a comment about a ban on rodeos in LA County and City Council will be speaking and is asking for support. This will be happening from 9 AM.
