III.02 Student Health Fee Increase, Information & Discussion Item, 25 minutes

The Senate shall receive a presentation on the proposal to adjust the Student Health Fee at Cerritos College to align with the Community College Chancellor's Office 2023-2024 Health Fee, seeking an increase to \$26.00 per semester and \$22.00 for the summer for enhanced mental health and healthcare services. Dr Chris Elquizabal, Dean of Student Accessibility & Wellness Services provided an overview of the Student Health Services, and a proposed Student Health Fee increase to support operations of the center and increased mental health services.

Financial Aid Outreach Coordinator Ismael Zapata presented about updates for 2024-2025 FAFSA application.
