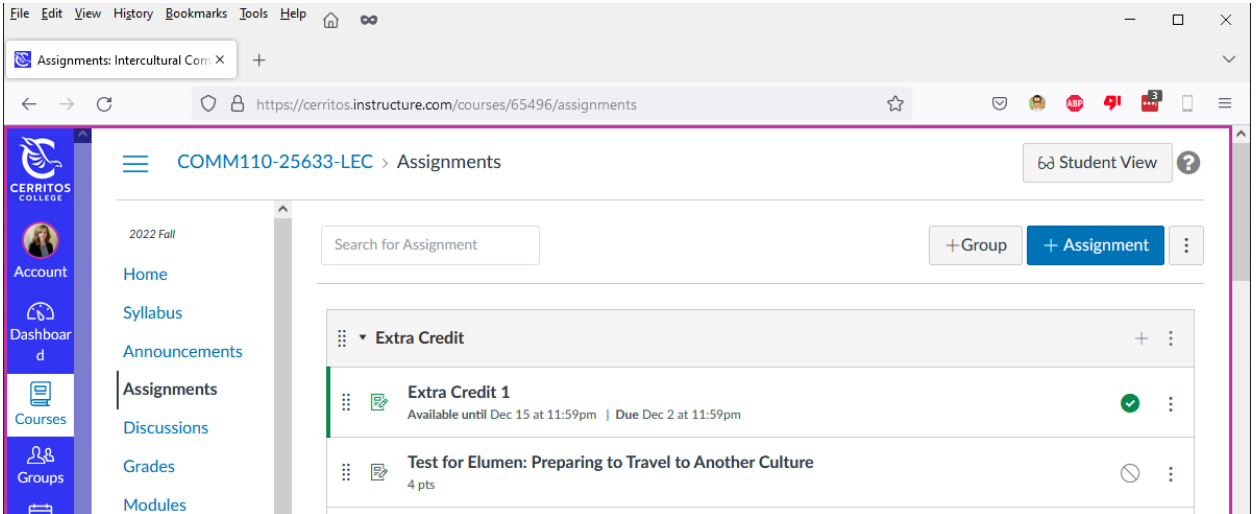
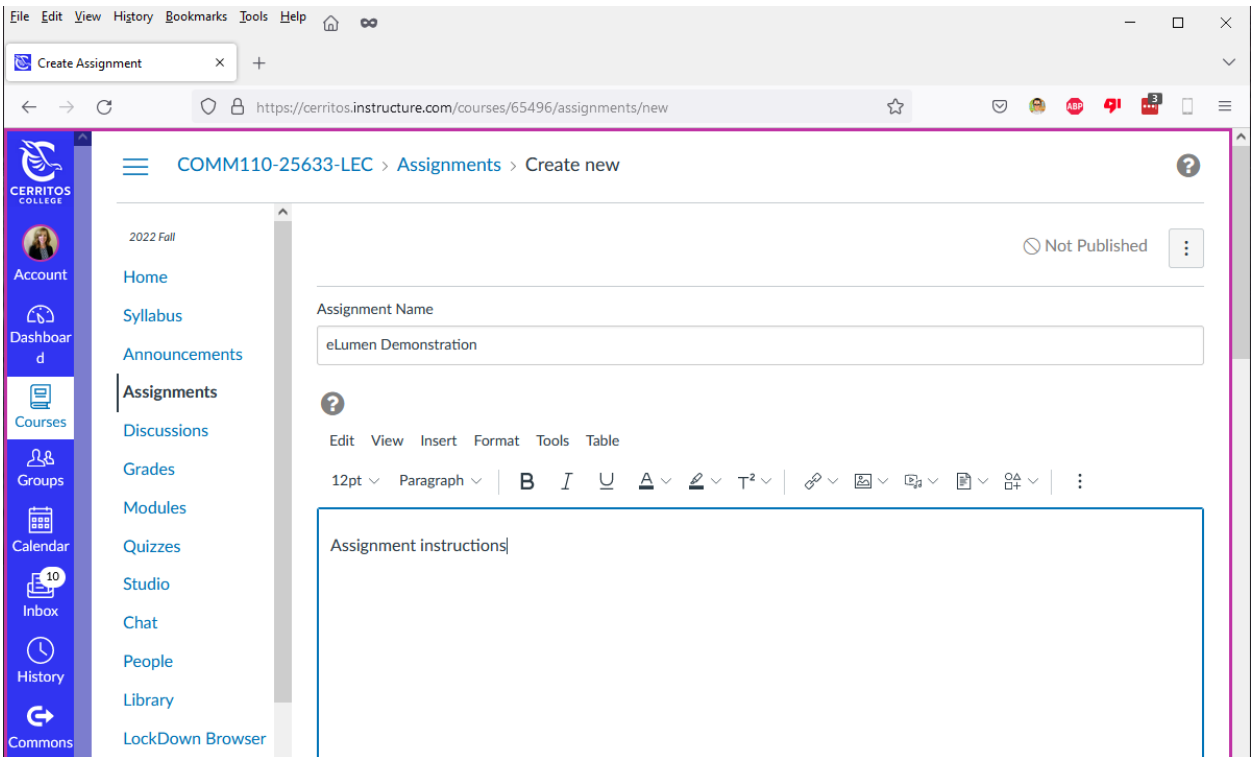


Adding eLumen to an Assignment in Canvas

1. Navigate to your course site in Canvas
2. Choose Assignments from the side navigation bar then click +Assignment



3. Enter an Assignment Name and any Instructions



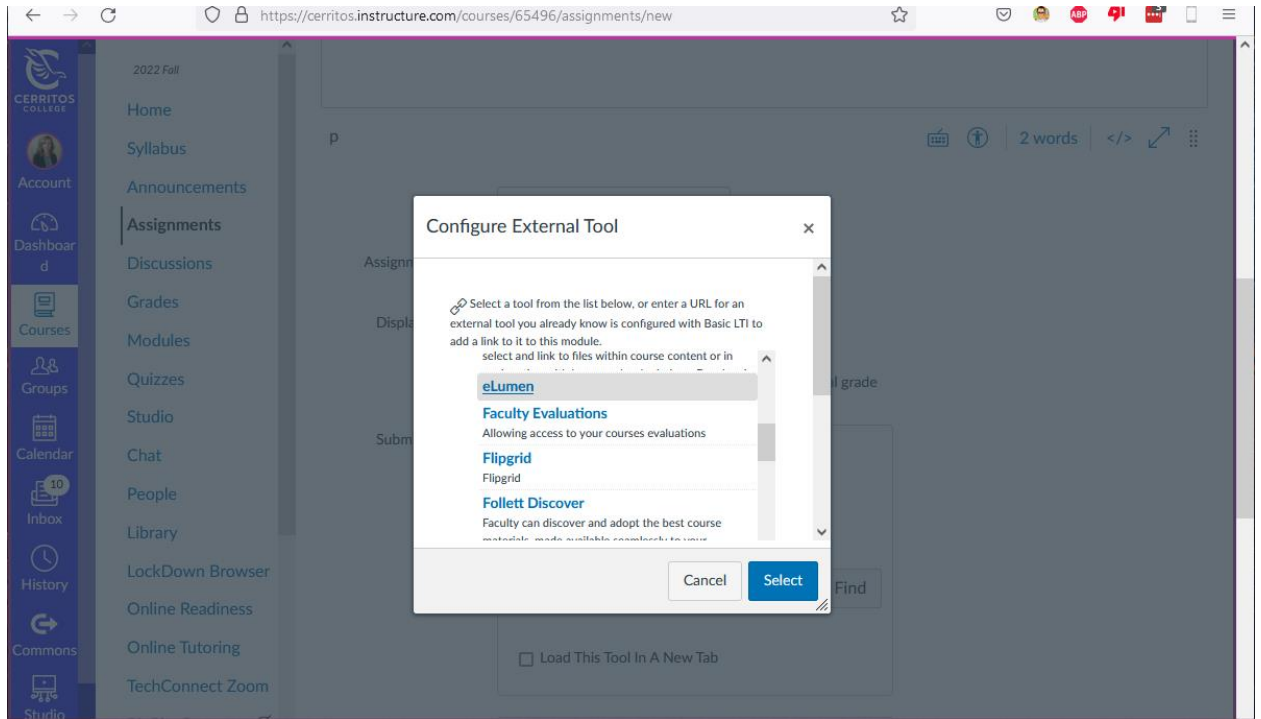
4. Next scroll down and enter the number of Points it will be worth and Assignment Group

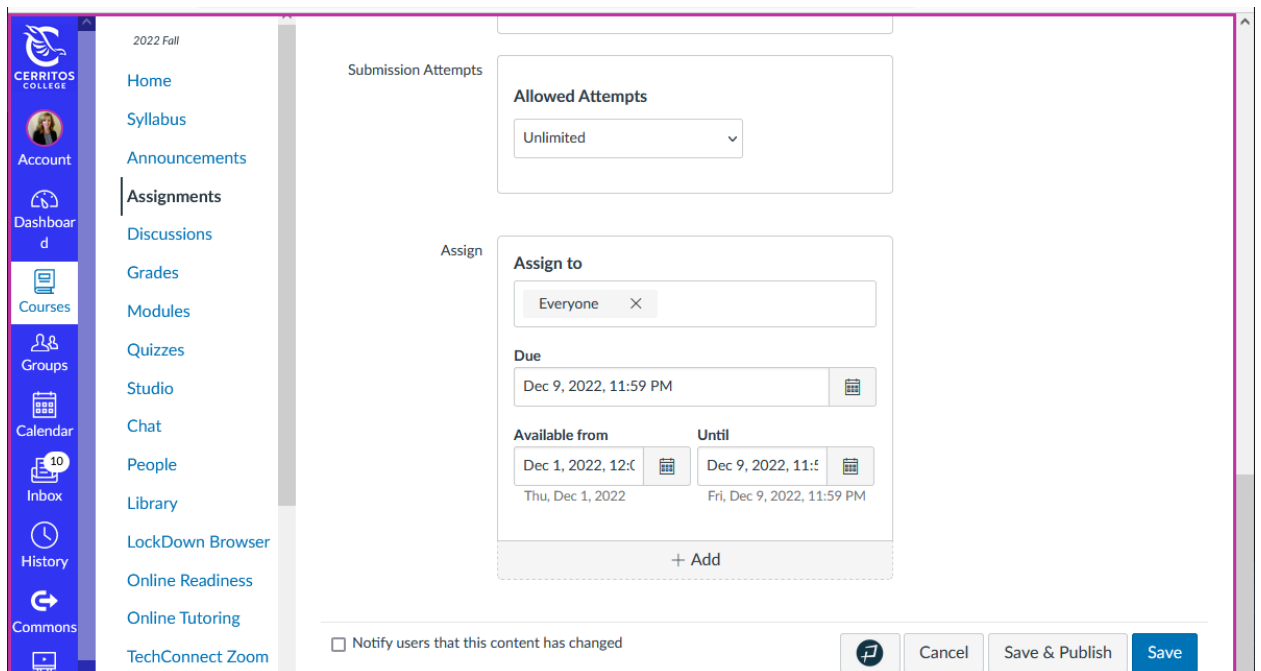
5. Now for Submission Type choose External Tool and click Find
