Kevin Kim from HP and Tami Reed from GST were at the meeting for a presentation from Kevin on the new products offered by HP. Some of the highlights from the presentation included information on bulk packaging, which saves on packaging materials and is available when purchasing form factor PC's. The new DC8200 series has been released w/VPRO as a standard and is available with a true quad core3 processor in the i5 model. The DC8200 series also has an integrated graphics card which is dual monitor capable. The cost for this model will be the same for the District as it received on the 8100 series desktops. Lee asked if the GUI Bios can be updated with one file and Kevin said it can be the only difference is that the interface has changed. Lee also asked if the DC8200 offered the same size hard drive and Kevin said it was the same size but now has an optional solid state drive for an additional cost. IT will evaluate a solid state disc drive. However, at this time Solid State drives are cost prohibitive at this time to establish it as a standard. Some discussion took place about the advantages of having a solid state drives. After Kevin and Tammy left Lee proposed to the committee that the DC8200 be accepted as the new desktop standard. There was a brief discussion that took place and the committee unanimously accepted the DC8200 as the new desktop standard.
