Still being reviewed • Drop have been seen after first week of instruction • College decided that everyone will be financially stable- faculty, adjunct faculty, and hourlies • Online for the rest of the Spring semester and all Summer • Summer registration is going on now • Contextualize all learning – content that is currently happening. Ex: understanding messages from state, how to find resources, apply for unemployment, etc. <p>e.
