## Draft of Accreditation Standard IB2

"Despite thorough and organized efforts for annual SLO assessment and improvement plans, internal and external factors have negatively impacted the process. Internally, Cerritos College has adopted Elumen to record SLO assessment reports and improvement plans. Elumen is not user friendly. Despite very thorough user guides provided by the SLO Coordinator, the program is widely viewed as difficult to use and a barrier to reporting SLOs and improvement plans. This has led many faculty to keep records of SLO assessment outside of Elumen, skewing the the reports in the program. A second challenge comes from the large number of courses taught by adjunct faculty. Adjunct, or part-time faculty, often teach at multiple colleges, whereby each college has different learning outcomes, different methods for assessment, and uses different systems for reporting, putting an unfair burden on these faculty members. Furthermore, at Cerritos College, part-time faculty are not contractually obligated to assess or report Student Learning Outcomes. Some of these issues have led to inconsistent SLO reporting across academic disciplines."
