### Gilman International Scholarship Quick Facts

- Up to \$5,000 to cover "program tuition and fees, room and board, books, local transportation, health insurance and international airfare." Students studying a "critical need language," may receive a supplemental award of up to \$3,000.
- 3,700+ scholarships will be awarded this year. Approximately 1 in 4 Gilman Scholarship applicants are selected to receive the scholarship.
- 1,424 scholarships were awarded in Summer 2019.
- Cerritos College students who have won a Gilman Scholarship:
  - o Two students (China 2014, 2016): \$4,500 each
  - o One student (India 2016): \$4,000
  - o One student (Cyprus 2016): \$2,500
  - o One student (UK 2017): \$3,500

### Gilman International Scholarship Eligibility, Timeline, and Application

- U.S. Citizen or U.S. National (American Samoa, Swain Islands, Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands)
- Recipient of a Federal Pell Grant
- Undergraduate student in "good standing at an accredited institution of higher education in the United States"
- Summer 2020 Application
  - Opens in mid-January 2020
  - Deadline is March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020
  - Scholarship recipients are notified at the end of April 2020
- Complete the application and essay questions

### Gilman International Scholarship The Statement of Purpose Essay

- How will studying or interning abroad help you achieve your future academic or professional goals?
- Why did you select your specific program and host country?
- What aspects of studying or interning abroad do you expect to be the most challenging for you?
- What knowledge, skills, and experiences will you draw on to meet these challenges?
- Maximum of 7,000 characters including spaces (approximately 1.5 single-spaced pages)

## Gilman International Scholarship The Community Impact Essay

- When you are overseas, how will you contribute to the mission of building mutual understanding between the people of your home community and the people of your host community?
- What are your project goals?
- Who is your target population/audience and why did you select them?
- How will you integrate the impact of your experience abroad into your project?
- What, if any, campus departments, student organizations, or community organizations will you collaborate with in bringing awareness to study abroad and the Gilman Scholarship?
- Maximum of 6,000 characters including spaces (approximately 1.5 single-spaced pages)

# Supplemental Essay for Critical Need Language (supplemental award of up to \$3,000)

- What are your motivations for improving your language proficiency academically, professionally, and personally?
- How do you intend to improve your language skills while studying abroad? How will you increase your proficiency in the language inside and outside of the classroom setting?
- How do you intend to use the language after you study abroad, and how will the Critical Need Language Award prepare you for this?
- If you plan to study in a country where the language does not appear in the list above, what are the benefits of and resources for studying abroad in your proposed country?
- The pink dot next to a language = priority is given to this language
- Maximum of 6,000 characters (including spaces)
