TRANSFER REQUIREMENT:

To be considered for upper-division admission to Liberal Studies, applicants must have completed the following seven courses (+) by the end of the prior spring semester for fall admissions or by the end of the prior summer term for spring admission:

- COMM 130, ENGL 100, or ENGL 100S, HIST 102, MATH 110A, and POL 101
- Select one of the following critical thinking courses: COMM 103, ENGL 103, ENGL 110, PHIL 103, or PHIL106, PSYC 103, READ 103
- Select one of the following English literature courses: ENGL 102**, ENGL 230A, ENGL 230B, ENGL 245, ENGL 246A, or ENGL 246B

All courses below must be taken for a letter grade. Applicants must complete with a minimum grade of "C" or higher the following coursework, with the exception of EDEL 200 which must be completed with a minimum grade of "B" or higher:
