This CSULA major has “major-specific admission requirements” which are focused on transfer student preparation that predicts success in the major and promotes timely degree completion. The criteria below reflect the current criteria as well as changes that will be used for the Fall 2021 admission cycle. The criteria listed will be reviewed annually for future admission cycles. For Fall term admission, coursework must be completed no later than the prior Spring term. **Be Aware:** Cal State LA is currently only considering transfer students for Fall 2021 admission. Should additional space be available, Spring 2022 applications may be considered in the future.
