# III.05 Funding Request for Black Excellence Collaborative Graduation, SB-2223-04, Discussion & Action Item, 20 minutes

The Senate shall discuss and take action on SB-2223-04, a funding request by BEC and Umoja to hold a Black Grad at the end of the Spring semester.

Senator Dunomes and Dr. Chelena Fisher, a counselor for UMOJA, present the Bill about BEC/UMOJA funding request.

Senator J. Hernandez moves to strike the 4th Whereas ("Whereas: The BEC and Umoja are seeking funding for XX students and up to two guests for Black Grad at the end of the Spring semester;") on the Bill. Senator Morales seconds. No objections.

Senator Diaz moves to approve item SB-2223-04 as amended. Senator Vashi seconds. No objections.

Senator J. Hernandez moves to pick up from the table items III.03 and III.04. Senator Flamenco-Medina seconds. No objections.

Senator Flamenco-Medina and Senator Roxas present the resolution for **Safe Parking at Night Act SR-2223-01.** This is for advocating the District change parking procedure, and does not change the procedure itself since ASCC does not have the authority to do that. It will have to be approved by the Coordinating Committee for the procedure to be updated.

Senator J. Hernandez moves to amend the resolution **SR-2223-01** by inserting a column to reflect Saturday after Friday with the same time and location and strike Friday and insert Saturday in the last Resolved. Senator Bartholomew seconds. No objections.

Senator Bartholomew moves to approve **SR-2223-01** as amended. Senator Dargo seconds. No objections.
