I.03 Approval of Minutes

III. New Business

III.01 Repeal of "Supporting Reform Of The Success Center" (JR-2223-07), Discussion and Action Item, 10 minutes

The Senate shall discuss and take action on repealing JR-2223-07.

Senator Dunomes wants to revise or reconsider the JR-2223-07.

Senator Dunomes moves to repeal **JR-2223-07**. Senator Morales seconds. No objections.

The Senator moves on to a roll call vote to repeal the Resolution.

With 24 Yes and 0 No, JR-2223-07 is repealed.

III.02 2023-2024 ASCC Budget (JL-2223-06) Discussion and Action Item, 60 minutes

The Senate shall discuss and take action on JL-2223-06, establishing the ASCC budget for 2023-2024

ASCC Treasurer David Hernandez briefly presents the Bill of ASCC Budget **JL-2223-06.** There was less revenue but more requests, so the budget had to be cut substantially compared to what was approved last year.

Senator Dunomes moves to reduce the budget of the **Leadership Conference** to \$54,500 from \$60,000. Senator Buckley seconds. No objections.

Senator J. Hernandez moves to increase the budget of **ASCC Spring Awards Banquet** to \$11,000 from \$10,500. Senator Diaz seconds. Senator Dunomes objects. Senator Dunomes rescinds his objection.

Senator Morales moves to reduce the budget of **Inter-Club Council** to \$22,500 from \$25,000. Senator Dargo seconds. No objections.

Senator Dunomes moves to reduce **Esports** to \$10,500 from \$12,000. Senator Morales seconds. No objections.

Senator Dunomes moves to increase **Commencement/Graduation** to \$79,200 from \$77,200. Senator J. Hernandez seconds. No objections.

Senator Dunomes moves to increase the budget of the **Accounting Club** to \$2000 from \$1500. Senator Diaz seconds. No objections.

Senator S. Reyes moves to reduce the budget of **Active Minds** to \$5500 from \$7000. Senator Dargo seconds. No objections.

Senator J. Hernandez moves to increase the budget of **Alpha Gamma Sigma** to \$11,000 from \$10,000. Senator Dunomes seconds. No objections.

Senator Diaz moves to increase the budget of **Cerritos College Artists** to \$1000 from \$500. No seconds. The motion does not pass.

Senator Morales moves to extend time by 20 minutes. Senator Alamgir seconds. No objections.

Senator Diaz moves to increase the budget of the **Chinese Club** to \$1300 from \$1000. Senator Sapkota seconds. Senator J. Hernandez objects. Senator J. Hernandez explains that \$300 is an amount that they can fundraise.

- Funding of the **Chinese Club**, with 3 yes and 16 no, the motion does not pass.

Senator Morales moves to fund the **Economics Club** of \$2500. Senator Desai seconds. Senator Chun objects. Senator Chun explains that stipends are not a priority to fund the clubs.
