DRAFT 2019 Commencement Speaker Criteria

The Commencement Speaker is an honorary participant of the graduation ceremony, and provides a 10-minute speech that serves to inspire and honor graduating students.

Eligibility

To be considered as the Commencement Speaker, the individual must belong to at least one of the following categories:

- Graduating student
- Hall of Fame Awardee
- Cerritos College Alumni (completed degree or certificate)

Speaker and Speech Requirements

- Provide remarks that are no longer than 10 minutes in length
- Is an engaging speaker, able to relate to the graduating student population
- Has a connection to Cerritos College, through being a graduating student, Hall of Fame Awardee, or noted Cerritos College Alumni
- Other...

Nomination Requirements – DRAFT BASED ON DISCUSSION

- Graduating student
 - Nominated by Cerritos College student, staff, faculty, or manager
 - Letter of recommendation provided by a faculty member, and staff or manager
 - Interview with the Student Life Committee?
- Hall of Fame Awardee or Cerritos College Alumni
 - Nominated by Cerritos College student, staff, faculty, or manager
 - Interview with the Student Life Committee?

Other possible requirements and considerations:

- GPA requirements for students?
- Short statement or draft of speech?
- Will self-nominations be allowed?
