- In order to carry out the duties and responsibilities set out in BP 2200, the Board will:
 - 1. Consider reports from the administrative officers concerning the progress and condition of the college;
 - 2. Provide adequate facilities, equipment, supplies, and other necessary facilities for the operation of the college;
 - 3. In accordance with the requirements of Education Code Section 81656 review purchase transactions every sixty days; Review this issue with other community colleges regarding compliance with Education Code, Section 81656;
 - 4. Consider communications from citizens or organizations on matters;
 - 5. Participate in the interview and selection process for the president. Final selection and employment for all other management/administrative positions, except under unusual circumstances, shall be based upon the President/Superintendent's recommendation of a candidate to the Board of Trustees for approval of employment. Establish the direction for and participate in the development of the District's Strategic Plan.
