9 A Campus Safety Plan shall be developed and provided to students as part of the Annual
10 Security Report Brochure published by the Campus Police Department by October 1 of
11 each year. This report is also available online at
12 <https://www.cerritos.edu/police/default.htm>.

14 The Campus Police Department prepares and annually updates a report of all
15 occurrences reported to campus police of and arrests for crimes that are committed on
16 campus and that involve violence, hate violence, theft or destruction of property, illegal
17 drugs, or alcohol intoxication, and of all occurrences of non-criminal acts of hate violence
18 reported to campus authorities. A written report will be submitted to the Board of
19 Trustees.

20 Written records of non-criminal acts of hate violence shall include at least a description of
21 the act of hate violence, the victim characteristics, and offender characteristics, if known.

22 **Note:** Education Code, Section 67380 defines “hate violence” as: “any act of
23 intimidation or physical harassment, physical force or physical violence, or the
24 threat of physical force or physical violence, that is directed against any person or
25 group of persons or the property of any person or group of persons because of the
26 ethnicity, race, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity,
27 gender expression, disability, or political or religious beliefs of that person or
28 group.” Section 67380 requires reporting of both occurrences reported to campus
29 police or safety authorities of and arrests for crimes that involve hate violence
30 (Section 67380(a)(1)(A)) and of “non-criminal acts of hate violence” (Education
31 Code, Section 67380(a)(1)(B)).

32 For purposes of reporting under the Clery Act, “hate crimes” include domestic
33 violence, dating violence, and stalking.

34 **Emergency Operations Plan**

35 The District shall develop and maintain an Emergency Operations Plan, which shall be
36 distributed as appropriate.
