Vacancies on the Board of Trustees may be caused by any of the events specified in
Government Code, Section 1770 or any applicable provision in the Elections Code, or by
a failure to elect. Resignations from the Board of Trustees shall be governed by
Education Code, Section 5090.

9 Within 60 days of the vacancy or filing of a deferred resignation, the Board of Trustees 10 shall either order an election or make a provisional appointment to fill the vacancy.

If an election is ordered, it shall be held on the next regular election date not less than130 days after the occurrence of the vacancy.

If a provisional appointment is made, it shall be subject to the conditions in Education Code, Section 5091. The person appointed to the position shall hold office only until the next regularly scheduled election for District Board members, when the election shall be held to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term.

The provisional appointment will be made by a majority public vote of the Board members at a public meeting.
