- by the Board itself and are not required to comply with the Brown Act or with these policies
- regarding open meetings, unless they are standing committees.
- Board committees have no authority or power to act on behalf of the Board of Trustees.
- 13 Findings or recommendations shall be reported to the Board of Trustees for
- 14 consideration.
