- 8 Board meetings in order to call attention to the solemnity of these occasions in the lives
- 9 of students and their families, and to invoke divine guidance and blessing, to show respect
- 10 for beliefs widely held among members of the community.
- 11 The Board of Trustees believes that the historical tradition of including an invocation is
- consistent with the practices of our Founders and members of executive, legislative and
- iudicial branches of government, as well as the two-century-old tradition at other public
- colleges and universities across the United States, including at our Nation's military
- academics, of including an invocation at important events.
- This policy is not intended, and shall not be implemented or construed in any way, to
- affiliate the Cerritos Community College District, nor express preference for, any faith or
- religious denomination. Rather, this policy is intended to acknowledge and express
- 19 respect for the diversity of religious denominations and faiths represented and practiced
- among the citizens in the community college district.
