Cerritos College CalWORKs Office is now offering **MORE** Educational Material Workshops.

Materials needed to process your request:

- Eligibility Documentation (Notice of Action, Verification of Benefits, GN 6005, GN 6005A, GN 6006)
- * Dated within the requesting semester.

Materials you must bring to workshop:

• Eligibility workers name, case number, file number, phone number and fax number

- Class Schedule Print-out or Registration Statement (preferred)
- Class syllabus if books/supplies are not on bookstore list
- If books and supplies have been purchased, bring copied of receipt(s).
- If not, bring bookstore print-outs (with price) of book and/or supplies for classes.
- If books were purchased at another location other than the Cerritos College bookstore, write the course name and number next to the book title on the copy of the receipt(s).

- If you have not purchased supplies, but plan on doing so, bring a store's shopping cart print-out indicating
- For faster processing, when searching on-line for books/supplies please place all items in "cart" to avoid individual printouts.

Did vou know CalWORKs has its own Work-Study Program?

What is CalWORKs Work-Study?

The Cerritos College CalWORKs Work-Study Program provides CalWORKs students with on- campus work opportunities. It helps develop and/or strengthen workplace skills while completing educational goals. With the help of dedicated on-campus employers, CalWORKs students learn how to enter and re-enter the workforce with the confidence that is needed to achieve career satisfaction and economic self-sufficiency. Work-Study is a time-limited program (2 years max) that allows students to earn extra income without it affecting their cash-aid benefits.

What are the Requirements?

- Receive the adult cash-aid portion and provide proof from the county
- Have a minimum of 18 units completed at Cerritos College
- Have a 2.5 Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Have at least 4 semester remaining at Cerritos College
- Note: Some requirements may be waived, on a case to case basis.

How do I sign up?

CalWORKs Students who are interested in Work-Study would first have to be referred by a CalWORKs counselor. Making an appointment with a counselor would be the first step. Don't forget to bring your resume!

What are the benefits of the **CalWORKs Work-Study Program?**

- Build work history
