# **Student Support Programs**

### WHAT IS EOPS?

### Extended Opportunity Programs & Services (EOPS) provides

"Over and Above" academic support and services to students who face social, language, educational and/or economic barriers.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Resident of California or AB540 eligible
- Completed Financial Aid application (FAFSA) or CA Dream Act application, and qualifies to receive the California Promise Grant (A or B)
- · Enrolled in 12 or more units when accepted into EOPS
- Completed less than 40 units from all colleges and universities
- Students who've been educationally disadvantaged in someway. Such as:
  - Being a first-generation college student
  - The primary language in the home is/was non-English
  - Graduated from high school with a grade point average below 2.50





# WHAT IS CARE?

The **Cooperative Agencies Resources** for **Education** (CARE) program provides resources and support necessary for single, head of household parents.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students must be eligible for EOPS and meet the following CARE criteria:

- Current recipient of CalWORKs/TANF cash aid, for yourself or your child
- At least 18 years of age or older
- Be single and head of household
