Batted .349 against right-handed pitchers and .324 against left-handed pitchers... Also batted .319 with runners

in scoring position... Over a 12-game period in the month of April, he batted .481 (25-for-52) and saw his batting average improve by 54 points... Went 6-for-8 with seven RBI in a two-game series against San Diego Mesa College... Also had a four-hit against Los Angeles City College (4-for-6, 2 RBI) and Long Beach City College (4-for-5).....

La Mirada HS: Named All-CIF as a senior after batting over .400 with eight home runs... Was a two-time 1st Team All-Suburban League selection... Named to the Press Telegram Dream Team as a senior, while also being named his school's Male Athlete of the Year... Batted over .500 as a sophomore and junior... Team went undefeated in league play his senior season... Also spent a year on the football team.....

Also started 45 games at third base and batted .252 with seven doubles and 15 RBI... Walked 20 times and stole three bases... Had 11 multiple-hit games, including a 3-for-6 game with two doubles against Cuesta College... Longest outing was against Palomar College, when he pitched four scoreless innings and struck out five to earn the win... Didn't allow his first earned run of the season until his eighth appearance and had pitched 15 1/3 innings... Surrendered earned runs in only three of his outings.....

St. John Bosco HS: Selected to the Press Telegram Dream Team as a senior and was a two-time 1st Team All-Serra League selection... Drafted by the San Diego Padres after his senior year... 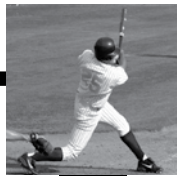

Batted .558 when leading off an innings and also hit at a .545 clip with runners on third base and less than two outs... Was most productive from the fifth spot in the batting order, hitting .364 (24-of-66)... Had eight games where he drove in two runs, including three in a row...
