About a week ago, I was talking to someone about Cerritos' chances of going to the Junior Rose Bowl and we figured it at about a 20 per cent probability. "But we've seen them come out ahead against worse odds than that," I observed and turned back to my typewriter to finish the article I was working on.

Now, with the seeds of superstition sown in my sub-conscious, I see that Cerritos suddenly shines the "cut under" category with Orange Coast College. They are the only two conference leaders with an 8-1-0 record.

However, an analytical glance at the two teams, a glance which the Junior Rose Bowl committee will no doubt take, tilts the works just decidedly in favor of the Falcons.

Among several factors in favor of Cerritos is one which shines very brightly—Ray Adermann. Adermann made the nation's junior college backs in scoring and tackling. And another factor which may have been previously overlooked in all the hubbub over "the run" is Clark Yeyna's fine passing record. Yeyna hit 22 receivers in 42 attempts.

Orange Coast College, on the other hand, hasn't a back in the top 25 in rushing or passing. A further weakness in the Orange Coast cause is the fact that the fumbled 47 times during the regular season.

None of these considerations, except the fumble, reflect on Orange's Coast's prowess as a football team. In fact, the reverse may be actually the case, since their wins have been owing to a team effort which can be regarded as a staid strength than the individual abilities of the athletes.

But all of these considerations, including the fumble, reflect on Orange Coast's prowess as a crowd pleaser. And the Junior Rose Bowl contest, to be an annual event, must maintain public interest.

Public interest is a wealth of which the Cerritos have an abundance. Aside from their merits as a football power, which compare quite favorably with Orange Coast's, the Falcons have caught the public fancy. John Public's reaction to the Falcons is like the rodeo crowd awaiting the appearance of a bull when a raging Brahma bull breaks from the pen.

Cerritos' 8-1-0 performance in their very first year out and against such competition as is encountered in the Western States Conference is an achievement never seen before in Junior College football in this area.

In addition to this is the fact that Cerritos Junior College serves a more populace area than Orange Coast College. In the Norwalk area, there is a larger public to become interested.

So with all this evidence favoring Cerritos over Orange Coast, my mathematical calculator is getting uneasy; feeling that the odds-breakers from Falcon are about to pull another long shot out of the hat.

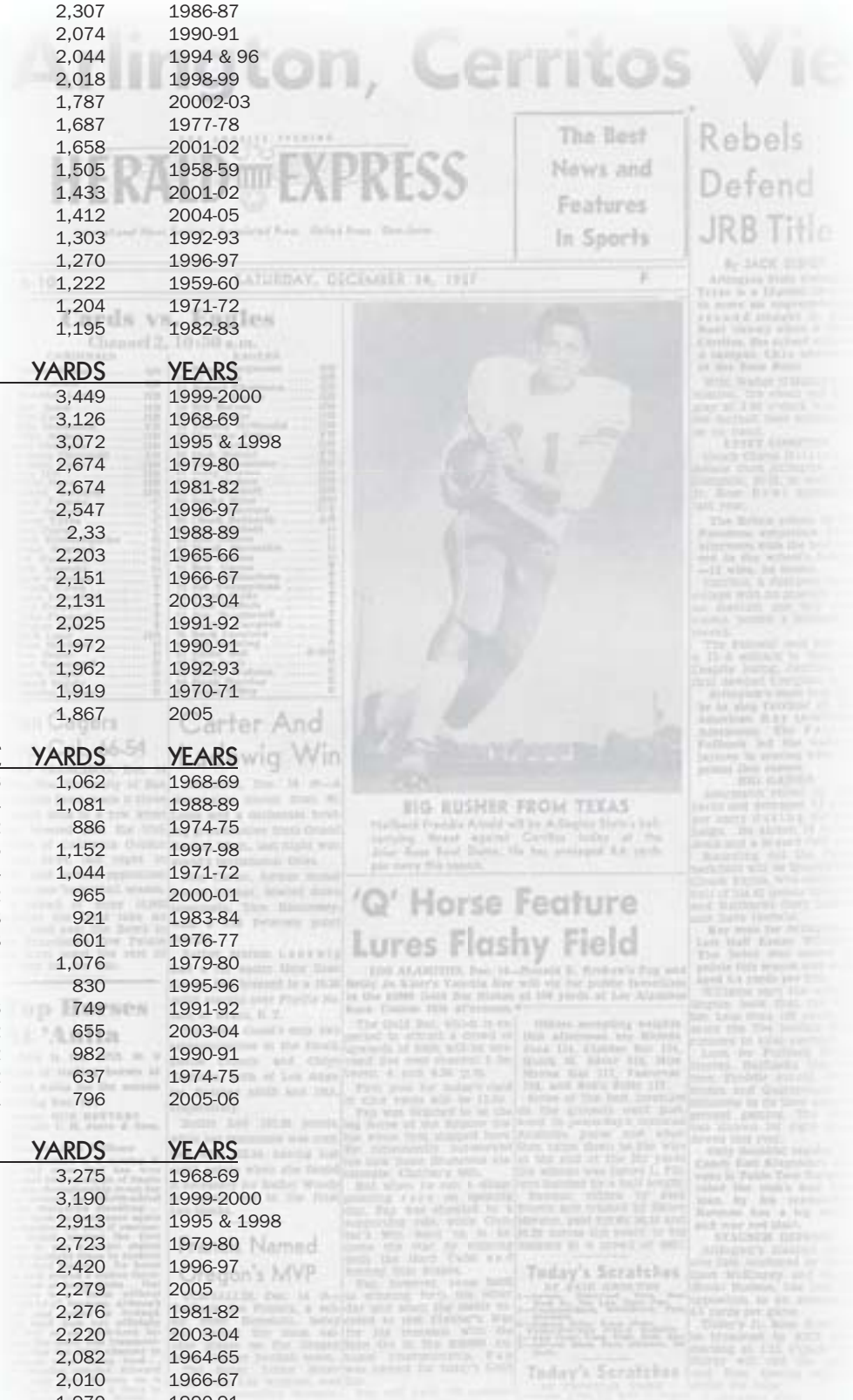
