

# SHELLEY HALL

INDUCTED INTO THE HALL OF FAME



**S**helley (Bowcutt) Hall, who set three career records, two single-season records and countless single-game records during the 1984-86 seasons at Cerritos College, was inducted into the California Community College Women's Basketball Coaches Hall of Fame on March, 13, 2004. Hall, who went on to play at Cal State Los Angeles, led the Falcons to their first ever South Coast Conference championship and state tournament appearance.

In her freshman year of 1984-85, the Falcons struggled to a 12-17 season, but watched Hall break the single-season scoring record with 575 points and averaged 20.7 points a game. But it was in her sophomore season that the Falcons began their current 20+ years of success and post-season accomplishments. The Falcons turned in a 25-8 record and won the conference title, as Hall broke the scoring record she set the season before by scoring 636 points (since broken) and averaged 20.5 points a game.

Hall still holds the record for most career points (1,221), during a time where there was no three-point basket. Also a great defender, Hall set the school record with 64 career blocks after her two seasons, as well as registering 191 steals. In the 65 games in which she played, Hall scored in double figures in 63 of those contests, which included streaks of 31 and 25 games.

## A TRADITION OF SUCCESS

**T**hroughout the history of Cerritos College women's basketball, the program has experienced a great deal of success. The program has been in existence for the past 28 years and during that span, the team has won or shared eight South Coast Conference championships and has advanced to the state tournament six times. Head coach Karen Welliver has been at the helm for the past 22 years and has compiled a stellar record of 492-231 and was the coach for each of the conference championships and all the state tournament appearances. She is closing in on being just the sixth California Community College women's basketball coach to win 500 games. But she couldn't reach the milestone without a great group of student-athletes to come through the program. Below is a list of accolades won by former Falcon players over the years.
