1. CALL TO ORDER

Don Mueller called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. via ConferZoom.

2. APPROVAL OF THE JULY 21, 2021 & AUGUST 18, 2021 MEETING SUMMARY

The July 21, 2021 & August 18, 2021 minutes were approved. Judi Holmes abstained.

3. EMERGENCY POSTERS

Don Mueller reported that the Emergency Posters are up in classrooms. His cadets are putting them up.

4. RAVE GUARDIAN SAFETY APP

Don Mueller said that the Rave Guardian app is up and running, even though it was purchased several years ago. Anthony Parker mentioned that the android version of it is a little different. Don Mueller said that there is a safety walk feature – user to take a contact from their phone list, so that person will know where they are at.

5. CAMPUS SAFETY INSPECTIONS

Reports from Mayra Radillo, Ramona Mellgoza, Diane Loera and Victoria Vaja, (Team) who walked the area #4 – Emergency Blue phone, the writing/signage is unreadable. North PST building – bush is overgrown on the pathway. Metals building area – trash and brush are collecting between this building and PST. Santa Barbara building – asphalt, small patch, is broken. Trip hazard between west side of Woodshop and SBB. Woodworking building – sign, for COVID check-in, is down. Metals building – pavement is being worked on between ME-3 and ME-2J. Parking Lot 8 – overgrown & dry shrub off of Studebaker Road. Anthony Parker said that Facilities is addressing this issue. Lot 9 – general clean-up of pines & needles. HS building – sprinklers going off at 2:15 pm occasionally.

Don Mueller asked if any other teams had anything to report. Anthony Parker said he saw only a few issues in his reporting area. Area #5 – overgrown trees, missing sign and a Stop sign that is leaning over a bit.

Don Mueller talked about the issue with the barricade on Gridley and "old" Falcon Way. A person had crashed thru it. He is working with the city of Norwalk to have it repaired and have it as a more "permanent" fixture, possibly a wall. It is coming up on a year since this incident happened.

6. ITEMS FROM THE FLOOR

Anthony Parker said that the Burnight Center demolition has started on the inside of the building, behind the fenced area. This process will be following all safety precautions. Anthony Parker mentioned that Miya Walker has been working on getting information to the students, campus wide, on this. Don Mueller said that temporary lighting has been placed on the north side, of the BC building, for safety/security purposes.
