OPTION D (LVN 30-UNIT OPTION / NON-DEGREE) Licensed Vocational Nurse

The Nursing Program offers to qualified Licensed Vocational Nurse applicants advanced placement into the second year of the program. LVNs are given the opportunity to prepare for registered nurse licensure by completing thirty (30) units of college course work. The LVN who only completes the thirty units designated by Cerritos College is eligible for the NCLEX-RN examination for licensure as a "non-degree" Registered Nurse. <u>This license is only valid in California</u>. This option may also limit the student from going further in their education to obtain a bachelors or master's degree.
