Falcon Basic Needs

Purpose and Goals

The Falcon's Nest provides centralized support services for students facing basic-need insecurities. This is accomplished through access to on- and off-campus resources, community collaboration, and advocacy that ensures a student's educational success.

Student Population Served

We serve students who are food and housing insecure. This population tends to be older than our general campus population and has more representation from female identified and Black/African American students.

Number of Students Served Annually and Capacity

We serve 1,000 students annually; maximum capacity is unknown at this time as we haven't reached that point yet.

High-Impact Interventions

The students may receive food, clothing, and temporary housing, all of which have been proven to help these students stay on their educational pathway.

Intended Impacts and Measured Outcomes

We are currently setting up measures to track Black/African American enrollment because these students utilize the services offered at the Nest at a higher rate than other student groups. We want to be proactive in serving these students.
