Purpose and Goals

EOPS is a student support program that provides "over and above" academic support and other services to students who face economic barriers to education, as well as social, language, or educational barriers.

Student Population Served

EOPS serves those that are financially and educationally disadvantaged in some way. It provides extra support and services that can make the difference in students being successful in their educational journey.

Number of Students Served Annually and Capacity

EOPs serves more than 1,000 students per year; it has a capacity of 1,300.

High-Impact Interventions

EOPS is "high touch," meaning students receive priority registration, at least 3 counseling appointments each semester, as well as EOPS grants, necessary school supplies, access to a lending library, free tutoring, a computer lab/place to study, workshops and events, and even a cap and gown when graduating!

Intended Impacts and Measured Outcomes

EOPS intends to increase persistence and retention rates and the completion of math and English in our students' 1st year.
