On average, the Facilities Department addresses 2,600 work orders annually. Moreover, Cerritos College just completed its 20th year of the general obligation bond construction program which has allowed us to complete more than 50 projects including two LEED certified buildings, the Health and Wellness Complex, and the Performing Arts Center.
