Completion of courses to attain an Associate in Arts in Geography for Transfer Degree at Cerritos College will prepare students to complete a baccalaureate degree in Geography at a university within the California State University system. Geography is a holistic discipline that examines the relationship between cultural (i.e., religion, economic activities, ethnicity, land use, etc.) and physical (i.e., weather and climate, geomorphology, biogeography, etc.) processes and the interrelationships of these dynamics as each greatly affects the other. Geographers study an array of subjects with a spatial view and attention on patterns on the landscape. This program is for seamless transfer to CSU system.
