# Common Assessment

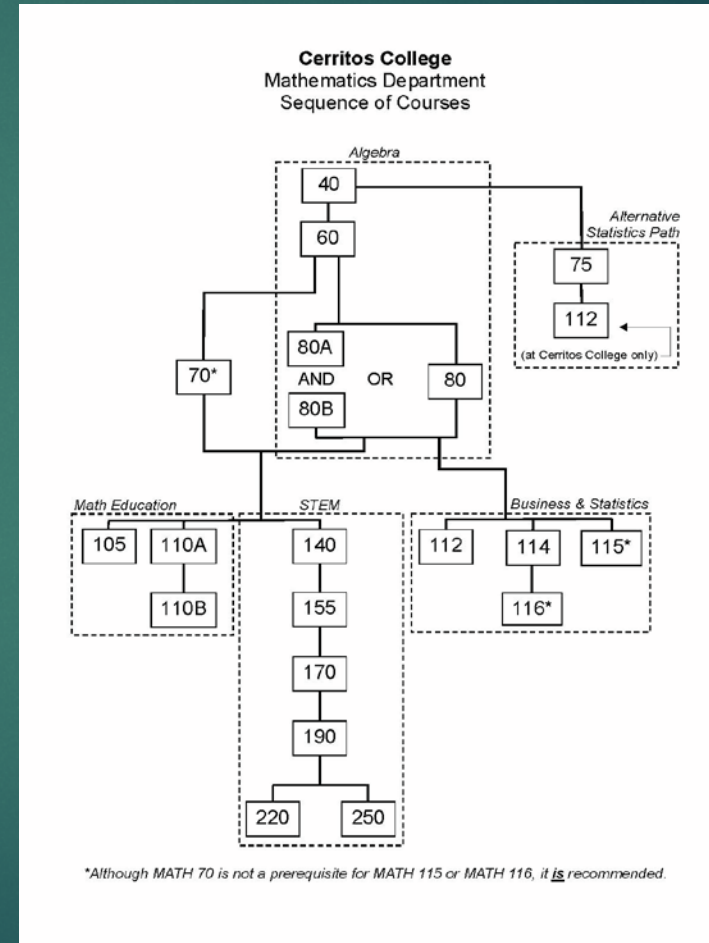
- ▶ Statewide Initiative
- ▶ Consistent Across Campuses
  - ▶ Common Assessment, Not Common Placement
- ▶ Piloted at 12 Campuses across the State
- ▶ We are mapping competencies for Math, English, ESL, and Reading
- ▶ If pilot is successful, we may implement as early as fall of 2018

# High School Transcripts

- ▶ Service-Area Schools submit their student data
- ▶ Math and English have established their criteria, a slight modification of the Multiple Measure Assessment Project Criteria
- ▶ Pilot GPA placement through Cerritos Complete, AIME, and EOPS
- ▶ Collect data to validate our Multiple Measures
- ▶ AB 705
