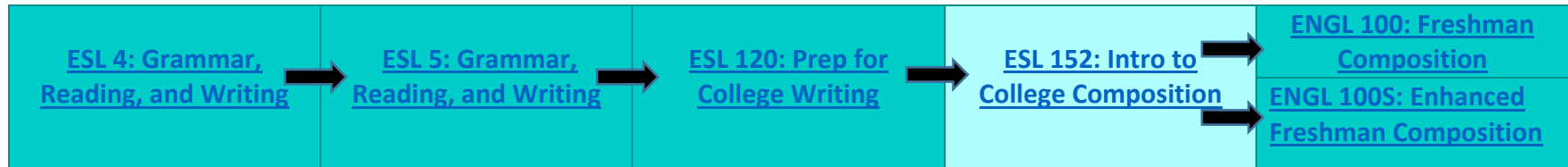


ESL 152: Introduction to College Composition
