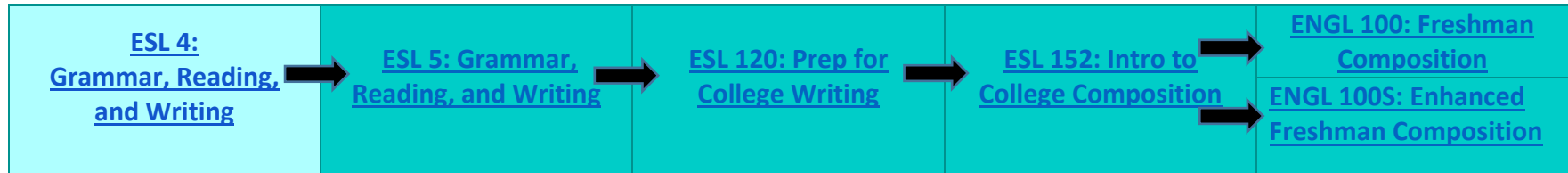


ESL 4: Grammar, Reading, and Writing

- Editing writing for correct grammar, sentence structure, and vocabulary
