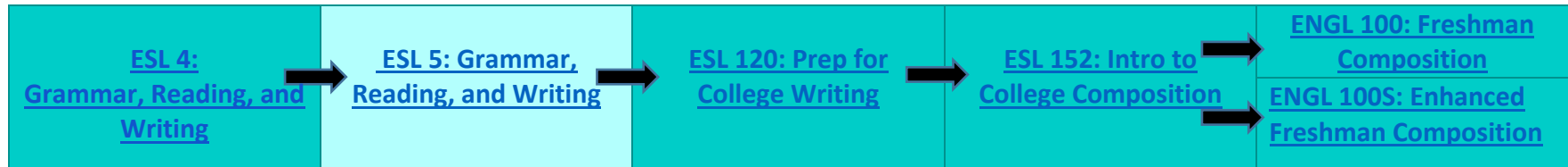


ESL 5: Grammar, Reading, and Writing

Why this course: You should enroll in ESL 5 if you are a multilingual/ESL student who wants to work on writing fluency, in particular writing paragraphs in English. In this course, you will write academic or professional paragraphs; read and analyze college-level materials including textbooks, short stories and articles; discuss college-level readings, using new vocabulary, using English to ask questions; and practice listening skills by following instructions, lectures and presentations in English.

What you should already know:

- Read and write short academic and professional texts in English and have an
- Advanced understanding of sentence structure, verb tenses and word forms

What will be challenging:

- Listening to and reading short passages
- Writing paragraphs and giving short presentations
