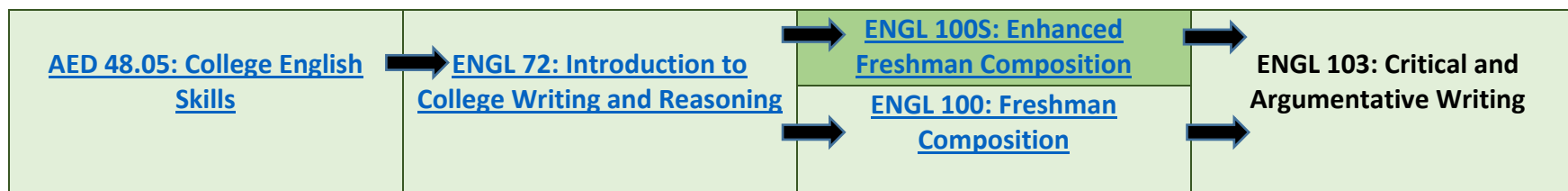


ENGL 100S: Enhanced Freshman Composition

4.5 Unit Transferable Course



Why this course: This course covers the same content as a traditional English 100 course, but it meets for two additional hours per week, giving you more time in class to work on your writing and more individualized guidance from your instructor. You should enroll in English 100S if you feel somewhat less confident in your college writing skills and believe you would benefit from extra time with your class peers and instructors to help develop those skills. In this course, you will write multiple essays, from 4 to 10 pages in length, present supporting evidence in MLA style, develop research bibliographies and integrate research into argumentative essays. You will also engage in a process of drafting, revising, and editing your writing.

What you should already know:

- Writing complex sentences that present strong vocabulary and analyses of readings, including of novels
- Editing your writing for spelling, punctuation, grammar choices, and language chosen for a specific audience

What will be challenging:

- Analyzing readings, including a novel, short stories, or play, and incorporating ideas into your essays
- Developing multi-sentence paragraphs that focus on an idea supported by evidence

To meet these challenges:

- Spend 12 hours a week or more completing homework and studying for the course
- Visit the Instructor's Office hours
- Seek feedback from the Writing Tutors in the Success Center.
