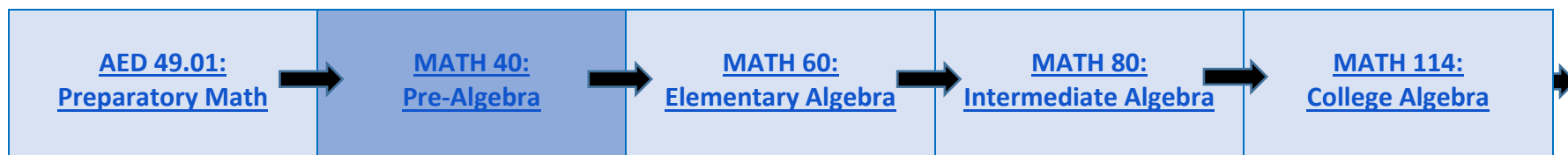


MATH 40: Elementary Algebra

4.0 Unit Non-Transferable Course



Why this course: You should enroll in Math 40 if you do not have a strong background in Algebra and need a refresher course on arithmetic and basic algebra. This course is your first glimpse of algebra, as such, you will learn informal geometry and applied arithmetic, including percentages, rates, scientific notation, tables, graphs, the real number line, numerical relationships involving lines, angles and polygons, and how to solve simple equations.

What you should already know:

- How to add, subtract, multiply and divide whole numbers, fractions, and decimals

What will be challenging:

- Integer Rules: adding a positive number to a negative number; multiplying two negative numbers
- Linear Equations: solving for x

- Spend 10 to 12 hours a week completing homework and studying for the course
