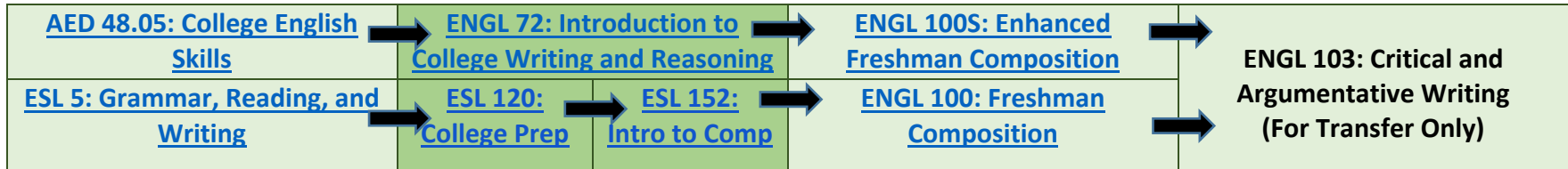


ENGL 72: Introduction to College Writing and Reasoning

5.0 Unit Non-Transferable Course



Why this course: You should enroll in English 72 if you feel less confident in your college writing skills, need more practice and support, and want to prepare to pass Freshman Composition. In this course, you will write multiple essays, from 2 to 7 pages in length, begin to learn MLA style for quoting outside texts and building bibliographies, practice complex sentences and editing skills, and engage in a process of drafting, revising, and editing to successfully communicate ideas to your readers.

What you should already know:

- Writing sentences that present complete thoughts, develop multi-sentence paragraphs that focus on a single idea
- Editing your writing for spelling, some punctuation, and clear language

What will be challenging:

- Transitioning from the five-paragraph model to longer, more varied essays.
- Incorporating secondary sources into essays.

To meet these challenges:

- Spend 10 to 12 hours a week completing homework and studying for the course
