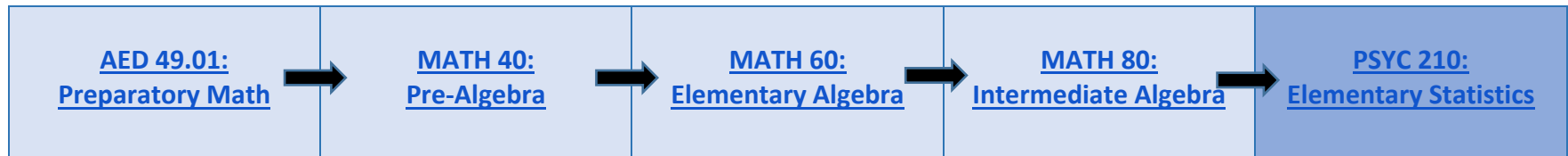


PSYC 210: Elementary Statistics

4.0 Unit Transferable Course



Why this course: You should enroll in PSYC 210 if you are interested in learning about how statistics are used in the behavioral sciences. It is a college-level course in statistics and requires a basic math background, such as order of operations, square roots, exponents, fractions, and decimals. In this class, you will learn descriptive statistics, research methodology, and inferential statistics. You will complete laboratory assignments, utilize various statistical formulas and notations, and analyze data using statistical computer software program(s).

What you should already know:

- Order of operations, square roots, exponents, fractions, decimals, percentages, and proportions

What may be challenging:

- Inferential Statistics
