***FIELD IRONWORKERS APPRENTICESHIP (STRUCTURAL & REINFORCING)**

- The Field Ironworkers (FIW) Apprenticeship Program prepares students to become journeymen in the field of Ironwork. Individuals interested in the FIW program have the options of completing the “Structural” OR “Reinforcing” pathways. Students will gain the skills and knowledge that involve steel and cable reinforcing in concrete construction (rebar work), erections of steel skeleton of buildings, window wall & curtain wall exteriors, rigging of heavy machinery & welding in conjunction with all aspects of these jobs’ descriptions.

***PAINTING & DECORATING CONTRACTORS OF AMERICA APPRENTICESHIP**

- The Painting & Decorating Contractors of America Apprenticeship Program prepares students with all applications of painting that include varnishes, lacquers, sealers, stains, and any necessary preparations prior to application. Students will gain the skills required to perform work on all types of buildings, both interior and exterior.

PRE-APPRENTICESHIP ELECTRICIAN TRAINEE (WHOLE RESIDENTIAL ELECTRICIAN & NON RESIDENTIAL LIGHTING TECHNICIAN)

- The Pre-Apprenticeship Electrician Trainee Program prepares students with the skills and knowledge required to becoming a state certified C-10 Residential Electrician OR Non-Residential Lighting Technician in California. Students interested in either options will gain the skills necessary to perform work for an electrical contractor installing, constructing, or maintaining any electrical system that is covered by the National Electrical Code in residential buildings OR Non-Residential Lighting fixtures and retrofit.

***COMING SOON: METRO’S RAIL OPERATIONS OF MAINTENANCE-OF-WAYSIDE SYSTEMS APPRENTICESHIP (TRACK INSPECTOR, TRACTION POWER INSPECTOR, & SIGNALS INSPECTOR)**

- The Metro’s Rail Operations of Maintenance-of-Wayside Systems (MOW) apprenticeship prepares students in gaining the skills and knowledge required to become a journeyman in the field of Track Inspector, Traction Power Inspector, OR Signals Inspector. Individuals pursuing any of the three options may perform work inspecting & repairing track and switches in yards, performing inspections, testing, installation, maintenance, and repair of wide range of electrical power apparatus, and/or inspecting, testing, and performing corrective and preventative maintenance of wayside signals.
